

# Providing Cemetery Information & Images

We are looking for volunteers who want to add Eller and Eller-related cemetery information to the Eller Family Association website ([www.ellerfamilyassociation.com](http://www.ellerfamilyassociation.com)). To keep the online information consistent, here's what we're asking for:

1. Name of Cemetery
2. Town, County, State of Cemetery
3. Location of Cemetery. We'd like longitude and Latitude information but a street address will work.
4. A representative photo of the cemetery. Perhaps the entry sign or a wide photo of the area.\*
5. A diagram of the area where the Eller graves are found, with the individual graves noted. This is very optional as this may be difficult in larger cemeteries.\*

Once we have the cemetery information, we'd like this information on the individual Eller or Eller related grave stones.

1. Name on the stone
2. The photo name or number so we know which one goes with this person.
3. Birth/Death dates (as best you can read them)
4. A photo of the stone.
5. Any brief biographical information you know (ie. "son of John Smith and wife of Mary Jones.")\*
6. Family line (ie. George Michael) and the individual "Person ID" number in the Eller Database. Just look up the individual on the website and provide the number listed as the "Person ID" (ie. I 234).\*

\*These items are very helpful in entering the information but are not required.


For an example, go to the website and under the "Find" tab, click on "Cemeteries" (figure left).



You will come to a page showing the indexed cemeteries (figure right).

Then click on, for example, Fairfax County (red arrow).

You'll go to a page with all the cemeteries in that county we've indexed (in this case, only one). There'll be a Google map to locate the cemetery and an index of the Eller stones there and a link to a larger photo of the stone and a link to the individual and his/her family.
